## Time Commitment

The Leadership Chatham class year begins with an Opening Reception & Orientation the evening of September 06, 2018. The year ends with graduation in June of 2019. All educational sessions are daytime sessions that begin promptly around 8:00 or 8:30 a.m. and end between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. These full-day sessions are held one time a month, typically on the second Thursday of the month. The Team Building session, held in September, is sometimes scheduled on a Tuesday or Wednesday. Please reference the tentative schedule included in this brochure. There are times, outside of scheduled sessions, that participants meet with their class and a Chamber representative to discuss and work on their class project. Project meetings usually take place over lunch.

## Acceptance into the Leadership Chatham Program

There is a maximum of 25 participants accepted for each class year of Leadership Chatham. Participants with diverse experience and involvement in the community are accepted on a first- come, first-serve basis.

## Graduation Requirements

Participants missing more than one (1) session are not eligible to graduate with their class. Missed sessions can be made up in the next class year at no additional cost to the participant. Participants are eligible to graduate once sessions are made up.

ACTIVE participation in the group's class project is a requirement of graduation for all participants.
